



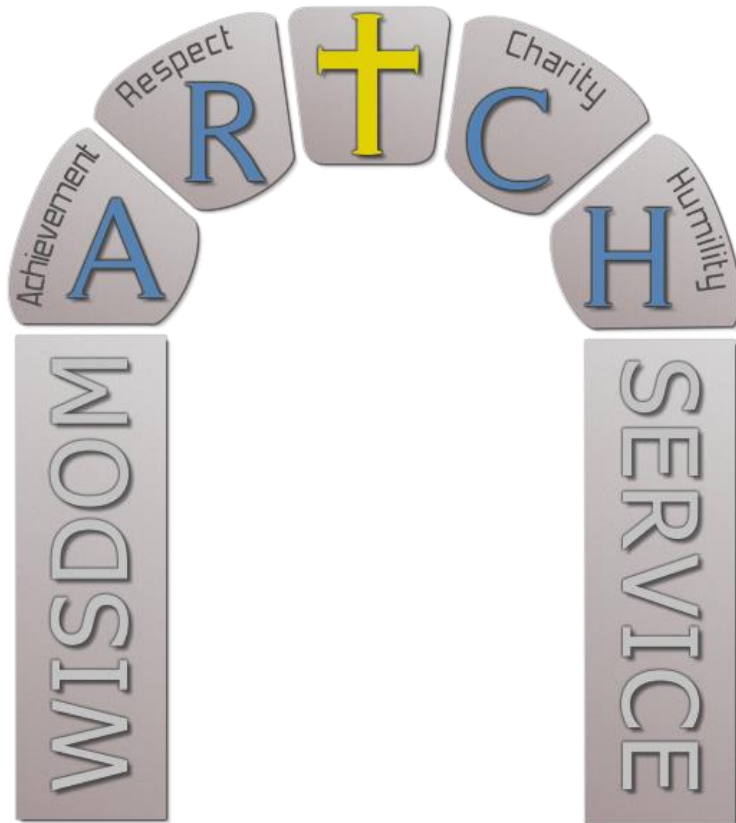

Achievement

Main Reception

Boys' uniform

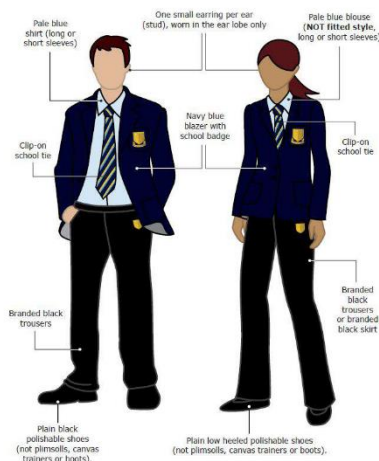
- Navy blue blazer with academy badge

When you start The National School you will have your finger scanned. This will take place in the canteen.

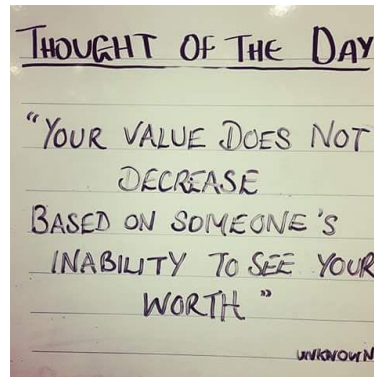


When you want to buy something, you scan your finger at the till.

 - House Assemblies

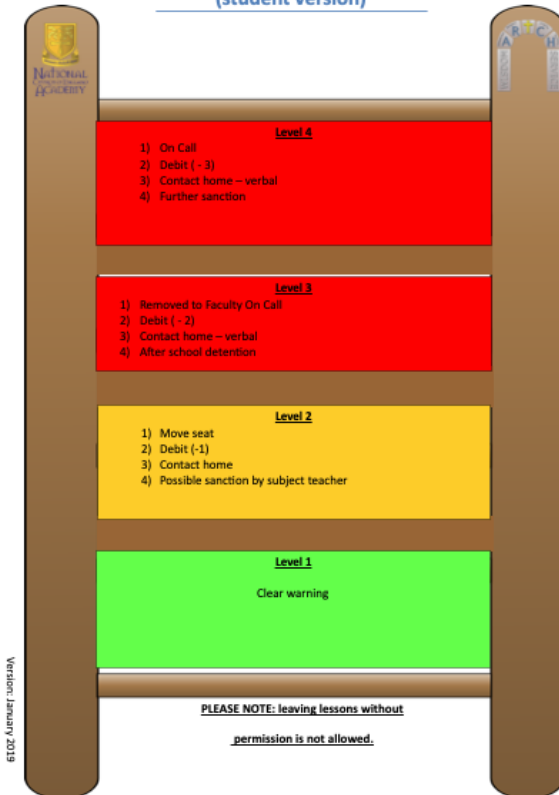

Should your behavior fails to meet expectations:
