

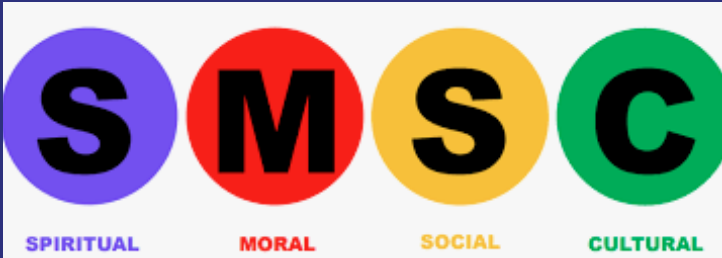

What is SMSC?

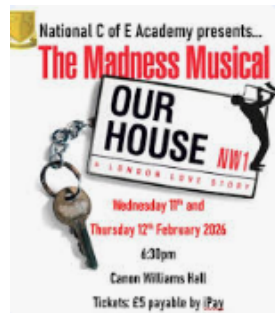
Underpinned by our vision of 'life in all its fullness' we provide opportunities for all students to develop socially, morally, spiritually and culturally.
