## **Creating mind-maps**

- Creating a coloured mind-map allows you to make notes in a different form and also provides a more visually engaging way of revising those notes.
- 1. Write the **main topic** in the middle of the page and draw a ring around it;
- 2. For each **key point** that comes off the main topic in separate **branches**, use a different colour;
- 3. Ensure key words & phrase stand out;
- 4. Look for links between the different branches and show these.
- It can also help to use **symbols/images** for key ideas so they standout.
