Making Flow Charts

- 1. Flow charts are a type of diagram that show a process from beginning to end;
- 2. Therefore, they are a great way of summarising a scientific, geographic, etc process [photosynthesis; formation of an oxbow lake);
- 3. Moreover, they can also be used to summarise an historical event's key moments e.g. League of Nations OR to summarise the plot of a text e.g. Macbeth;
- 4. Each stage of the process should be labelled with 1-2 key words, again to aid Skimming before the exam;
- 5. Coming off the key words should be a slightly more developed explanation.
