Exam skills

With many exams, you get marks for constructing an argument [e.g. English, history] so think carefully about how you can make your argument clear:

- Use explaining phrases: This signifies/shows/implies that; This highlights/underlines that ...; This suggests that ...;
- Use evaluative words: This is significant /noteworthy/ important as ...; Use connectives [linking] words: furthermore; moreover; in contrast; alternatively;
- Check for basic spelling and punctuation errors. Look for errors with their/there, to/too.
